

The Classis meeting that was originally scheduled for January 15 has been re-scheduled for February 19 at Princeton CRC in Grand Rapids. This meeting (6-7:30 pm) will feature a workshop for anyone interested. The workshop description is as follows: Congregations today are met with a new fast changing culture. There is a sense of urgency to recognize the cultural influences on the church and the new tools and skills that are needed for the congregation to meet these changes.
