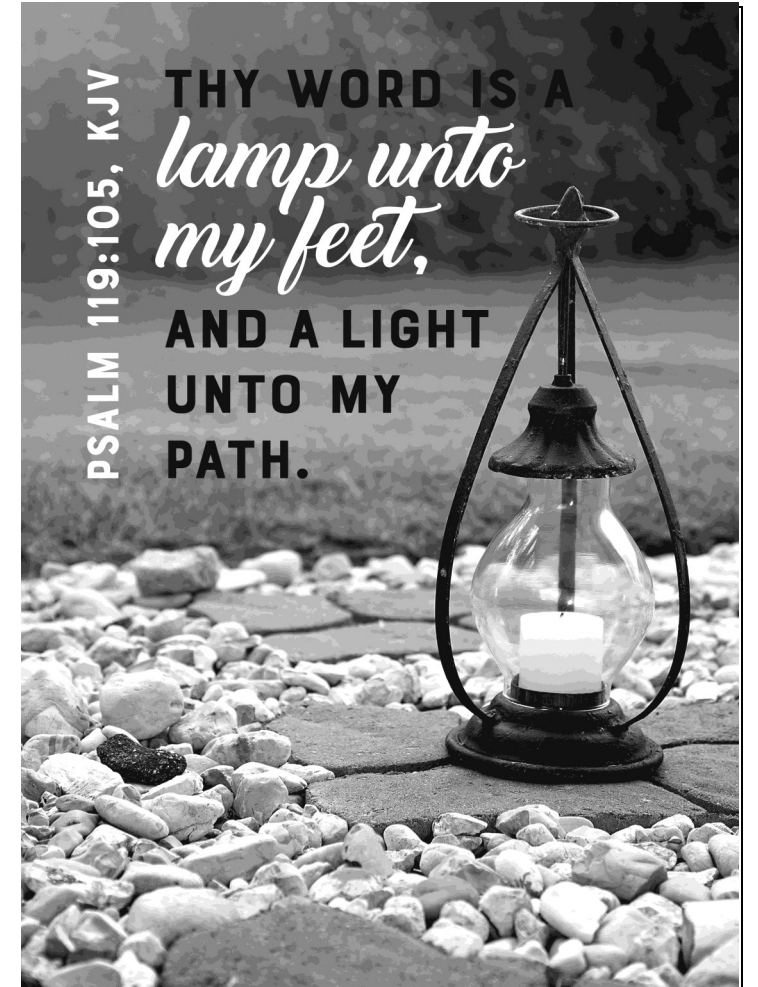

This morning, as we continue our series on the Word of God/Scripture, we turn to the most concise statement about God's Word found in the Old Testament, and some would argue the entire Scriptures. Psalm 19 is a Psalm dedicated to letting the readers know how Creator/Redeemer God reveals himself to His creation. The first way is through nature, or His creation itself, and the second way is through the written Word. Theologians call these two modes General Revelation and Special Revelation. God speaks to us through His works and through His word.
